Visiting

As you are aware visiting for care homes has changed slightly and there is no limit on when you can visit or who can visit. However, our goal is to keep the residents as safe as possible, so we ask the following:

Continue to book appointments to visit Peasmarsh Place. Staff still need to clean between visits, which can take some time. Booking an appointment means there is time to keep the care home clean and keep your loved ones safe.

Lateral Flow Tests are mandatory, a negative test result must be shown to a staff member prior to visits taking place. If you have not tested, you will not be permitted to visit.

PPE must be worn during the visit.

Visits are still encouraged to take place in Jasmine or outside (weather permitting)

Visits to rooms can take place at the managers discretion
