Our Care Consultant partners undertake repeat audits on a regular basis to ensure that our standards remain high.

We follow a comprehensive and all-encompassing approach to infection control and the management of measures to protect all our Residents and Staff from the Coronavirus and its variant forms.

This includes:

- Regular testing of all staff and testing for visitors / contractors to the home when requested or as a part of a risk assessed approach.
- Testing of residents at the home as a safety measure when this appears appropriate.
- Strict adherence to all measures directed by Public Health (East Sussex) in relation to new Resident admissions to the home.
- Use of highly sophisticated Infection Control processes Ozonating devices, Temperature sensing devices for staff, Virucidal fogging, rigorous cleaning and deep cleaning regimes.

Our staff are highly trained in infection control processes and we utilise a range of measures including daily use of tried and tested disinfection regimes.

We also work in close partnership with Public Health (East Sussex) to ensure that our standards stay high for the protection of our Residents, visitors and Staff.
